

SECTION 101 BOARD MEMBERSHIP

1. Four (4) school board members shall reside in the city of Portage and be elected at large throughout the entire district.
2. Three (3) school board members shall reside in the attached areas outside the city limits of Portage and be elected at large throughout the entire district.
3. The seven (7) member school board represents the Portage Community School District.
4. One (1) representative of the senior high school student body may be elected by the students to serve with the School Board for a term of one (1) year.
 - a. The student member elected shall not be entitled to vote with the school board.
 - b. Qualifications for the student representative and the election procedures are to be established by the Student Council.
 - c. If the elected student representative is unable to attend a Board meeting, any member of the Senior High Student Council may serve as an alternate.
 - d. The School Board encourages Student Representatives to attend all School Board meetings.
