

SECTION 145 ORIENTATION OF NEW BOARD MEMBERS

1. Prior to the first meeting following the election or appointment, the district administrator shall meet with the new member for the primary purpose of orienting the new member to Board responsibilities, method of operation, and to school district policies and problems. The new member shall be given a tour of the facilities and be introduced to administrative personnel.
2. The new member is to be provided with copies of all appropriate publications as identified by the District Administrator and Board President and the web address to all Board policies.
3. New Board members will be encouraged to attend workshops, seminars, and conventions sponsored by state and national school and education associations.
