

SECTION 272 PART-TIME/FULL-TIME PUPILS' ATTENDANCE (defined)

1. A pupil will be considered to be a "full-time" pupil for membership purposes:
 - a. if enrolled in at least 2 classes per term and 4 or more credits per year in grades 9-12.
 - b. if enrolled in grades K-8 and is scheduled to attend classes the following amounts of time each day.

165 minutes in grades Kdgn - 1 - 2 - 3
195 minutes in grades 4 - 5 - 6 - 7 - 8
 - c. if the district has contracted with another educational agency for the pupils' instruction and pays the necessary fees.
 - d. if enrolled, but in lieu of attending school, is receiving homebound instruction at district expense.
2. A pupil will considered to be part-time:
 - a. if enrolled in kindergarten, meets legal requirements, and is scheduled to attend at least 60 minutes daily ($\frac{1}{2}$ membership count).
 - b. if enrolled as a 3-5 year old pupil with exceptional education needs (counted as $\frac{1}{2}$ membership)
 - c. if enrolled but is scheduled to attend less than the requirements of Rule 2 a or b above (not counted in membership)
