

Fund 60, the Student Activity/Organization Fund is for student body activity/organizations. All Student Activities/Organizations must be approved by the building principal and be assigned a faculty advisor. The advisor shall be for the collection and disbursement of all funds under the supervision of both the building principal and the District Business Office.

All activities/organizations shall be on a self-sustaining basis. Each activity/organization is responsible for generating necessary funds to maintain a positive balance in each account. Accounts will be audited annually to ensure accepted accounting practices have been utilized in the management of each account and that dollars spent have been on items or services directly benefiting students and/or their activity.

At the end of the school year all balances will be carried over to the next school year with the exception of the funds of the senior class. The senior class or class officers, after covering the expenses and activities of that class shall designate before the end of the school year how any remaining balance will be spent. Any funds remaining in the graduating class treasury at the end of the school year of graduation will be transferred to the freshman class.
