

## SECTION 379 – LIGHT MAINTENANCE/GROUNDS

### **I. Supervision**

- a. All maintenance personnel are directly supervised by the Director of Buildings and Grounds, or his or her designee.

### **II. Technical Skills**

- a. The maintenance/grounds position requires proficiency in the operation and maintenance of hand tools, power tools, lawn care equipment, snow removal equipment, field painting equipment and other equipment as provided by the Portage School District.
- b. All maintenance/grounds positions require a valid driver's license and the ability to pass a school driver's physical.
- c. This position requires knowledge and skill in the use of gas and or electric welding, brazing, and soldering.
- d. This position requires the technician to be proficient in the operation of personal computers and the systems they control i.e. Johnson Control metasys, etc.
- e. Proficient in the everyday operation of the district/city swimming pool.

### **III. Physical Qualifications**

- a. Able to lift and carry a minimum of 70 pounds, testing is required.
- b. Able to perform the following activities over a sustained period of time, climbing, lifting, walking, stooping, bending, and standing.
- c. Able to work at heights of up to 30 feet.

### **IV. Responsibilities**

- a. Familiar with the operation and maintenance of district irrigation equipment.
- b. Responsible for Athletic Field painting/preparation, lawn care and snow removal.
- c. Works directly with the district Food Service Director in the delivery of bulk food supplies.
- d. Swimming pool maintenance

### **V. Certification**

- a. Certified Pool Operator certificate with in 12 month's of start position.
