

517 STUDENTS COMPLETING HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL COURSES PRIOR TO HIGH SCHOOL

A student below grade 9 who satisfactorily completes a high school course will have the option of the grade earned recorded on his/her high school transcript. Satisfactory completion is defined as receiving an overall course grade of an A or B (note: a grade of "C" may also be approved upon recommendation of the teacher of the course). The course will count toward the 24 credits required for graduation, but will not count toward high school cumulative GPA. Any student may elect not to receive credit for the course and retain the option of repeating the course at a future date.
