

SECTION 570 NATIONAL COMPETITIONS

It is the intent of the school board of the Portage Community School District to support excellence in student achievement in school-sponsored events whenever possible, to the extent of its ability to do so.

Thus, when a student qualifies for a national competition through his/her successful effort in a state competition for a school-sponsored activity, the board may authorize financial support for the student and one advisor. Additional advisors will be at the Board's discretion.

Board support for national competition will be limited to a maximum of 50% for the student and 100% for pre-approved expenses for the advisor. The support would be for registration, transportation, and lodging for the student competing in the national competition and the advisor. Additional nights, meals, activities, and transportation are not included.

Portage Community School District will support the student who was enrolled at the time they qualify for the national competition. The support will extend to the student competing during the summer immediately following graduation provided the student and their parent sign a conduct form stating they will follow all co-curricular, school, and advisor rules and regulations and successfully complete the competition or the district support would be forfeited.
