

SECTION 640 SAFE AND HEALTHFUL SCHOOL FACILITIES

It is the intent of the School Board to provide safe and healthful school facilities. To this end the following steps shall be taken.

- Rule 1. The school board will develop, adopt, and record a long-range plan for bringing the district facilities to the level of standards for safe and healthful facilities.

- Rule 2. The school board will comply with all regulations and state codes from DILHR and DHSS and applicable local safety and health codes and regulations.

- Rule 3. The buildings and grounds supervisor shall be responsible for an annual inspection for potential or demonstrated hazards to safety and health. Any changes needed will be reported to the district administrator and the school board.

- Rule 4. The buildings and grounds supervisor shall be responsible for maintenance procedures and custodial services being conducted in such a manner that the health and safety of persons using the school's facilities are protected.
