Guidelines When Law Enforcement Interviews Students

- 1. Law Enforcement will check in with an administrator at the building.
- 2. Students will be interviewed during study hall or passing time if possible or when it is most convenient for the student/ teacher.
- 3. The student will be advised that they do not have to talk to law enforcement and can leave at any time.
- 4. Students can request that a parent, an administrator or their designee be present during the interview.
- 5. When students are interviewed, they will be place closest to the door and have the option to have the door open or closed.
- 6. Parents will be notified when interviewed by someone other than the school liaison officer. When possible, the parent contact will be made prior to the interview.
- 7. Any statements given to law enforcement personnel may be used against the person giving the statement.
