<u>Alternative Diploma Program (Madison College-Portage)</u>

Students who meet the State of Wisconsin's definition of "at-risk" may be approved to attend Madison College-Portage to earn his/her high school equivalency diploma ("HSED"). In order to enroll in the program, Madison College-Portage requires students to be 17 years old and have a 9th grade reading level by taking a TABE test. Contracting for the alternative diploma program is completed through a scheduled appointment with the Madison College-Portage counselor, the student, and a parent. The cost of the program is paid by the school district but the student is responsible for the payment of the separate tests and attending 15 hours per week.
