R.K.A Word Solving Strategies

A.1. Students will:

- a) Confidently use picture cues and language patterns to read familiar and predictable material.
- b) Use beginning letter sounds.
- c) Ask for help at an unknown word.

R.K.B Response to Literature

B.1. Students will:

- a) Formulate appropriate questions.
- b) Understand print contains a message and adequately show understanding through responses.
- c) Retell and sequence a story with some prompts (character, setting, and problems).

R.K.C Alphabet/Letter Recognition

C.1. Students will:

- a) Identify all 26 uppercase letters and lowercase letters quickly and automatically.

R.K.D Letter/Sound Relationship

D.1. Students will:

- a) Identify 26 letter sounds (21 consonants, and 5 short vowel sounds).

R.K.E Concepts of Print

E.1. Students will:

- a) Demonstrate directionality of print (read left to right, top to bottom, and return sweep), point under each word as they read.
- b) Know the difference between a letter and a word.
- c) Recognize parts of a book (front, back, title, and author).

R.K.F Word Recognition

F.1 Students will:

- a) Automatically read basic high frequency/sight words (word lists and within a story).
