W.K.A Prewriting

A.1. Students, with teacher support, will:

- a) Brainstorm their own ideas.
- b) Identify their own topic and idea for writing.
- c) Generate ideas from pictures or verbal prompts.

W.K.B Drafting

B.1. Students will:

- a) Use sounds to write unknown words.
- b) Write known words.
- c) Write a simple sentence that makes sense to the writer and teacher.

W.K.C Conference/Respond

C.1. Students, with teacher support, will:

- a) Re-read using one-to-one matching (fingerpoint, as they read each word) and understand the pictures/writing.
- b) Conference about writing.

W.K.D Revising

D.1. Students will:

- a) Revise their words, pictures, and sentences after receiving feedback from the teacher.
- b) Expand and add details to pictures and text. Attempt to include their own voice in the writing.
- c) Match pictures and text.

W.K.E Editing

E.1. Students will:

- a) Write left to write, top to bottom, and return sweep.
- b) Attempt to use basic writing conventions (capitalization, spacing, and punctuation).
- c) Write most letters with accurate formation and use lowercase letters appropriately.

F.1. Students will:

- a) Write high frequency words correctly in everyday writing.
