

How to Choose a “Just Right” Book

- 1 Read a page of the book out loud
- 2 Every time you come to a word you don't know or can't pronounce, put up a finger.

0-1 finger – EASY (read for fun, not for class)

2-3 fingers – JUST RIGHT

4-5 fingers – CHALLENGING (save for later)

To see if you will like a book:

- Look at the author
- Read the back of the book
- Look at the cover
- If the characters sound real
- Read the title
- Read the first few pages
- A good one I've read before
- Look at the pictures
- If someone else says to read it
- Look at the words
