

Admission Guidelines for UW System Colleges

UW – Eau Claire

Top 30% of class with a minimum ACT score of 23. Decisions after February 1.



UW – Green Bay

GPA of 2.98–3.60 (on a 4.0 scale) and minimum ACT score of 20. Decisions made on rolling basis.



UW – LaCrosse

Top 25% of class (rigorous academic courses) with a minimum ACT score of 23. Decisions after February 1.



UW – Madison

GPA of 3.50 minimum (on a 4.0 scale) and minimum ACT score of 27 or SAT score of 1860. Admission is competitive and selective. Students with the strongest qualifications, including number of courses taken, rigor of academic program (honors and Advanced Placement courses, etc.) and test scores have the greatest chances of admission. Personal characteristics that will contribute to the diversity of the University will be considered. See Freshmen Admission Expectations”.



UW – Milwaukee

Top 50% of class with minimum ACT score of 21. However, certain programs, including Architecture, Engineering and Nursing are more selective and require stronger academic preparation. Decisions made on rolling basis.



UW – Oshkosh

Top 40% of class with minimum ACT score of 21. Decisions made on rolling basis.



UW-Parkside

Top 50% of class OR a minimum ACT score of 20. Decisions made on rolling basis.



UW-Platteville

Top 50% of class OR a minimum ACT score of 22. Engineering requires a minimum ACT math score of 22. Engineering students who do not meet these minimum requirements will be placed in pre-engineering until completion of calculus and analytic geometry with a grade of "C" or better.



UW-River Falls

Top 40% of class OR a minimum ACT score of 22. Elementary Education applicants: top 40% with a minimum ACT score of 24. Students who meet two of the three elementary education admission criteria (rank, test scores and college preparatory credits) will be considered on a space-available basis. Decisions after February 1.



UW-Stevens Point

Top 35% of class, minimum of 3.27 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) with a minimum ACT score of 21. Decisions made on rolling basis.



UW-Stout

Top 50% of class OR a minimum ACT score of 22. Manufacturing engineering and applied science applicants: Top 40% with a minimum ACT math score of 22 OR a minimum ACT score of 22 with a minimum ACT math score of 22 OR 3.0 grade point average with a minimum ACT math score of 22. Decisions made on rolling basis.



UW-Superior

Top 50% OR a minimum GPA score of 21. Decisions made on rolling basis.



UW-Whitewater

Top 40% likely to be offered admission. Decisions made after January 1.
