SUMMER SCHOOL RULES

- All PHS Student Handbook rules and consequences are in effect throughout the summer school program.
- Prompt and regular attendance/activity is mandatory.
 - o Students are required to log-in and work the full two hours of their assigned session. One 5-minute break is permitted.
 - o If for any reason a student cannot begin school work at the time scheduled, a parent/guardian should call the school office (742-8545 press "0") *before* class begins.
 - o Students are allowed two days (full or partial) of inaction without administrative approval before being dismissed with no credit earned for the time spent on coursework.
 - o Students are required to be on target at all times. If a student is not on target, he/she will be allowed one week to recover. After one week, student will be dismissed with no credit earned for the time spent on coursework.
 - o Once a student has completed the required coursework and earned the necessary credit, he/she will no longer need to attend summer school.
- If/When public health orders are lifted and in-person instruction resumes, the following expectations also apply:
 - o Students will be required to attend regular in-person instruction at PHS during their scheduled session.
 - o Students are not permitted to leave the school building after arrival. Students who must leave due to illness or an appointment are required to follow sign-out procedures through the classroom teacher. Failure to do so will be considered an unauthorized leave and the lost time will count against the attendance requirement.
 - o Please complete a Medical Consent Form available on the district website for any health concerns and/or emergency medications required during summer school hours.
 - o Transportation is not provided to students attending summer school.
