W.1.A Prewriting

A.1. Students will:

- a) Develop an appropriate plan for writing. (i.e. sketches, story web, and story map).
- b) Write for a specific audience with teacher support.

W.1.B Drafting

B.1. Students will:

- a) Use plans from pre-write to create meaningful text.
- b) Develop writing with a beginning, middle, and end.
- c) Use phonics, word chunks, and word endings (s, ed, ing) to write unfamiliar words.

W.1.C Conference/Respond

C.1. Students will:

- a) Conference with teacher about writing. (re-read their own writing to make sure writing is meaningful).
- b) Apply feedback from teacher to writing.

W.1.D Revising

D.1. Students, with teacher prompting will:

- a) Add or subtract feedback (details, events, descriptions, and important people/characters).

W.1.E Editing

E.1. Students, with teacher prompting, will:

- a) Reread to locate errors (spacing, end marks, and capitalization).
- b) Edit errors (spacing, end marks, and capitalization).
- c) Capitalize the first word of multiple sentences, days of week, months, and proper nouns.
- d) Use punctuation at the end of the sentences.
- e) Consistently write letters correctly.
