Suggestions For Improving Classroom Behavior

- * Cue to gain the students' attention.
- * Provide clearly defined rules.
- * Make sure consequences are understood.
- * Define for and with the students what behaviors are permitted.
- * Structure play situations or free time.
- * Assign short tasks. Divide longer tasks into shorter ones.
- * Be sure that all assignments are well within the student's ability to perform.
- * Limit the number of choices that students can make.
- * Provide consistent follow-up assignments.
- * Require completion of assigned work before recess or free time opportunities are made available.
- * Ask students to clear their desk or work area of any unnecessary items before starting a lesson or assignment.
- * Reinforce behaviors that are acceptable in your classroom. Be positive.
- * Avoid large amounts of seat work. Design your program to emphasize "doing" instead of "sitting."
