### About the Columbia County Pork Partners (CCPP) Scholarship

The Columbia County Pork Partners' Association Scholarship is awarded to high school seniors and college freshmen pursuing post-high school education. Preference is given to individuals who have been involved in and possess a sincere interest in the pork industry.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Applicants must possess a sincere interest in the swine or agriculturally related industry.
- All applicants must pursue post-high school education, i.e. college, vocational school, or short course.
- Only students who reside in Columbia County, WI are eligible to apply.

### **Scholarship Award Information**

- Columbia County Pork Partners will offer a \$500 scholarship to selected qualified candidates.
- The scholarship will be given in one payment, upon recipient's successful
  completion of the first semester as a full time student and proof of enrollment is
  provided at the beginning of the second semester. It is the recipient's
  responsibility to notify the Columbia County Pork Partners of their eligibility by
  sending proof of current enrollment and a copy of previous semester grades via
  email to columbiacountyporkpartners@gmail.com.
- A Selection Committee appointed by the Columbia County Pork Partners will
  use the selection criteria to screen the applicants and select the scholarship
  recipients.
  - The Selection Committee may recommend that the board of CCPP award more or less scholarships based on the qualifications of the applicants.
